

Approaching a Junction to emerge:

Remember you must approach a T junction at a speed and gear in which you can stop or carry on at. I.e. slow enough to stop and the gear in which to pull away in with some degree of quickness.

So on approaching a junction; mirror, signal, position and then start to slow the car down by footbrake and engine braking:

- assess the junction type
- Second or first gear depending on the visibility
- If it is an uphill junction go to first gear, as you WILL be going very slowly and stall your car if in second
- On looking at the junction check for traffic and if clear proceed if not then observation, brake and depress clutch. (Uphill clutch and then brake (when required)
 - Apply the handbrake if it was going to be a wait!
